1. Events Subcommittee (Dan, Kellie, Lisa)

Dan

- Dan spoke with Steve (recs department) all for more events-group would have to help
- o If we hitch our wagon to rec-then we can do alcohol-makes it much easier
- Memorial Day->Fitness-Hoptimystic-Poker Run would be a great event-(could be boat poker run too)
- Street races are hard to coordinate
- Needs to be one coordinated calendar (too many clashing calendars)
- o Tony-sponsor a cause (cancer, for example) as way to generate interest

• Kellie

- Spoke to Monihyan->no talk about doing the Chowder challenge this year
- Surveyed Sunapee Middle/High School kids to find out what they wanted
- o Physical-mini golf, 5Ks, cancer run, volleyball, gym
- Community->fair, better food, movies at the Livery
- o Competition->5K, fishing derby (ice), egg drop, skate competition, basketball court
- Other-Bakery, arcade, shops open more
- o Volunteers->ton of kids that are willing to volunteer-needs to be a central calendar

Lisa

- Spoke to Chief Cobb
- 5K Memorial Day weekend-concern about weekend that is packed (could we do Sunday morning as opposed to Sat morning?), parking management, EMS management. Maybe could be Monday morning.
- Stretch out calendar of events-

- o Anything that requires police to add detail will be additional costs and will be on us
- o Fire pit in harbor area-loved the idea, but fire hazard
- o Snowmobiles-could park on the ice in the harbor
- Mid-August lake event-like a kayak race or water events (Steve McGrath)
- Let's pick two events and do them well as opposed to trying to do too much

2. Underutilized spaces Subcommittee->(Pat, Tony, Cory)

- · Limited spaces in the harbor that need to be redeveloped
- Precision Machine-Reach out to Mr. Wiggins about ideas to use building to celebrate the heritage of manufacturing/the trades in Sunapee
 - o Eg., Turn it into vocation school
- Empty parking lot next to Livery
 - Need a boutique hotel maybe where the parking lot was
- Woodbine property-SHA bought that yesterday!
 - o Looking to the town to brainstorm, bring ideas
- Sky Lucas' property-if that were for sale that could be a great opportunity for bed/breakfast or some other business
- Empty parking lot on corner next to Historical Society->suggest some ideas of what we could do

3. Signage Subcommittee (Rick, Pam)

 No updates from the signage committee but Rick asked to be connected to signage subcommittee members from the Riverwalk committee.

4. Business Viability Subcommittee (John, Pete, Phil)

- What we need to make businesses viable
 - o Deed restrictions to reduce the tax burden of the properties
 - Shareholders lose
 - Town loses revenue, but could make it up in taxes from the businesses in the building
 - Encourage mixed-use (rental income/commercial)-apartments
 - Town is an obstacle to development and expansion for harbor businesses and needs to be more business friendly

- Zoning and planning boards/laws need to get more business friendly
 - Parking is an issue
 - Eg, Quack Shack needed refrigeration space
- Need more consistency in board rules
- Parking zoning rules need to relaxed
 - Town overestimating the parking that is required
 - Or we need to find alternative parking offsite
 - Need historic district zoning for setbacks, parking
- What businesses would we suggest the harbor needs to make it vibrant year round
 - o Boutique hotel-20-30 room
 - Another restaurant (3rd?)-Tacos/Burritos
 - Store to buy souvenirs, gifts, clothes (Rhonda)
 - Store to buy essentials-convenience stores-six boutique (Fentons)
 - o Bakery (Blue Loon)/coffee shop/bakery (don't have it)-Bend at Sugar River
 - Fresh Flowers
 - Artist working space would work
 - o Tanner's old place->organic coffee, really good wine
 - Ice cream (Quack)
 - Brewhouse (Hoptimysitc)
- Need Sunapee Harbor Association
 - To get people here need one association that can coordinate all events/business initiatives in the harbor
- Outdoor recreation
 - Connect Sunapee to the broad rail trail system in Newport/Newbury so that
 Sunapee could be destination for Snowmobilers, Hikers, Bikers using the rail trails.
 - E.g., Refinery is a destination for snowmobilers. Huge opportunity for Sunapee.
